Location: Primary location will be WMCA office Summer Lane, Birmingham, with frequent visits to Wednesbury Depot.

Role Purpose

To assist the engineering, safety and asset management leads in the operational and strategic delivery of West Midlands Metro asset management. Provide engineering expertise on all West Midlands Metro matters with a focus on monitoring the engineering performance and maintenance activities of the operator and maintainer Midland Metro Limited (MML) to ensure West Midlands Combined Authority (WMCA) interests are protected and we have assurance that maintenance and construction practices are being followed safely.

You will ensure that the engineering function of MML is adhering to safety policies and procedures and proactively address any emerging safety risks. Ensuring WMCA has clear oversight of MML maintenance activities.

You will ensure the MMA are following their processes during the design and build of the extension projects.

You will audit maintenance activities and documentary evidence of works completed to assure WMCA senior management that works are completed to the correct standard and works completed in a timely manner, carrying out inspections of the West Midlands Metro infrastructure as required.

You will review and analyse asset performance data in order to support asset management approaches, and illustrate those to the executives.

Responsibilities

- Obtain asset performance data from MML or MMA and analyse this data in order to identify trends and future maintenance interventions, ensuring the results are escalated to the Safety and Assurance and Asset Managers.
- Prepare technical briefs, identifying appropriate design standards and eliciting engineering requirements for renewals and enhancement works.
- Review tenders and proposals from contractors and evaluate technical aspects as requested.
- Escalate any safety critical matters that are identified and not closed out by the MMA or MML as appropriate to the Safety and Assurance Manager
- Conduct surveys and assessments to monitor the condition of the West Midlands Metro asset reporting the results back to the Asset Manager
- Undertake site visits across the Metro network to identify any defects and to address any urgent technical matters. Ensuring defects are properly reported and recorded and records maintained in order to ensure issues are tracked and closed out in a timely manner.
- Conduct audits of engineering activities using a schedule developed by the Safety and Assurance Manager, this will include process audits to ensure processes are followed, defects captured and closed out in a timely manner
- Undertake reviews/audits of design and/or construction activities, monitoring safety, environmental impacts and quality of design, construction, testing and commissioning activities, and ensuring that required management activities are adequate.
- Support the development of short, medium and long term maintenance and renewal plans
- Conduct checks of MML stock levels and raise any concerns with the Asset Manager.
- Support Metro projects with engineering input where required, including carrying out audits/site supervision of WMCA contracts
- As required review method statements, risk assessments, health and safety files, project documentation and handback information.
- Carry out regular audits of the MMA and MML Safety Management Systems following an audit schedule developed by the Safety and Assurance Manager.
